**AN ACT for the incorporation of the Retirees Association
of Trinidad and Tobago**

[Assented to 13th November, 1990]

WHEREAS there has been established in the Republic of **Preamble**
Trinidad and Tobago a community service organisation
known as "The Retirees Association of Trinidad and Tobago":

And whereas it is expedient that the said organisation
be incorporated for the purpose of exercising the powers
hereinafter set forth:

Enactment	ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:—
Short title	1. This Act may be cited as the Retirees Association of Trinidad and Tobago (Incorporation) Act, 1990.
Incorporation	2. The Retirees Association of Trinidad and Tobago (hereinafter referred to as “the Association”) is hereby created a body corporate.
Aims and objects	3. The aims and objects of the Association are to— (a) advance, secure and protect the interest, health and welfare of all members of the Association; (b) take an active interest in the civil, cultural, social, moral and educational welfare of its members; (c) promote activities and stimulate social interaction among its members; (d) unite its members in the bonds of friendship, good fellowship and mutual understanding; (e) provide a forum for the open discussion of all matters of interest to its members; (f) do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.
Powers of the Association	4. The Association shall have power— (a) to acquire by purchase, transfer, donation, exchange, devise, bequest, grant, gift, conveyance or howsoever otherwise, any real or personal property or any estate or interest therein; (b) to accept surrenders or reconveyances and to enter into contracts; (c) subject to any restraint, reservation or condition contained in the document under which it has acquired title to sell, exchange, devise, mortgage, or otherwise dispose of and deal with all property which may for the time being be vested in it.

5. All real or personal property of whatever nature now held by or vested in any person for the use and benefit of the Association is hereby transferred to and vested in the Association. Vesting of property

6. All documents requiring the seal of the Association shall be sealed with the common seal of the Association in the presence of the President and Secretary for the time being in office (or in the event of incapacity by some other person or persons authorised for that purpose by the Association) who both shall sign every such document and such signing shall be *prima facie* evidence that the said seal was duly affixed and that the same is the lawful seal of the Association. Mode of execution of documents

7. (1) The Association shall at all times have a fixed address in Trinidad and Tobago for the service of documents on the Association and such address and any change thereof shall be registered with the Registrar General within twenty-eight days of the date of incorporation or the change of address as the case may be. Service of documents

(2) Every document to be served on the Association may be served by leaving the same at, or by sending the same by registered post to, the registered address of the Association.

(3) Failure to register the address and any change thereof is a summary offence and renders the Association liable to a fine of one hundred and twenty dollars and to a further fine of ten dollars for each day during which the offence continues after conviction therefor.

8. The Association may from time to time make rules and regulations for the proper conduct of its proceedings and discharge of its duties, powers and functions with power to vary or revoke such rules and regulations. Power to make rules

9. Nothing in this Act shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of the State, or of any bodies politic or corporate or of any persons, except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Act and those claiming by, through, from or under them. Saving of State and other rights
