REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 22 of 1989

[L.S.]

AN ACT for the incorporation of the Lions Club of Mayaro  
and for matters incidental thereto.

*[Assented to 13th June, 1989]*

WHEREAS since 1979 there has been established the Preamble  
Lions Club of Mayaro:

And whereas it is expedient that the said Club be  
incorporated:

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment  
follows:—

- Short title            1. This Act may be cited as the Lions Club of Mayaro (Incorporation) Act, 1989.
- Incorporation        2. The Lions Club of Mayaro (hereinafter referred to as "the Club") is hereby created a body corporate.
- Aims and objects    3. The aims and objects of the Club are:
- (a) to create and foster a spirit of understanding among the peoples of the world;
  - (b) to promote the principles of good government and good citizenship;
  - (c) to take an active interest in the civic, cultural, social and moral welfare of the community;
  - (d) to unite the Club in the bonds of friendship, good fellowship and mutual understanding;
  - (e) to provide a forum for the open discussion of all matters of public interest, except that partisan politics and sectarian religion shall not be debated by members of the Club;
  - (f) to encourage service-minded persons to serve their community without personal or financial regard and to encourage efficiency and promote high ethical standards in commerce, industry, professions, public works and private endeavours;
  - (g) to associate with any companies, institutions, societies or associations having objects altogether or in part similar to those of the Club; and
  - (h) to do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.
- Powers of the Club    4. The Club shall have power to—
- (a) acquire by purchase, transfer, donation, exchange, demise, bequest, grant, gift, conveyance or howsoever otherwise, any real or personal property or any estate or interest therein;
  - (b) accept, surrenders or reconveyances and to enter into contracts;

- (c) sell, exchange, demise, mortgage or otherwise dispose of and deal with all property which may for the time being be vested in it, subject to any restraint, reservation or condition contained in the document under which it has acquired title.

5. All real or personal property of whatever nature now held by or vested in any person for the use and benefit of the Club is hereby transferred to and vested in the Club.

Transfer or vesting of property

6. All documents requiring the seal of the Club shall be sealed with its common seal in the presence of the President and the Secretary for the time being in office, or in the event of incapacity by some other person or persons authorised for that purpose by the Club, who shall both sign every such document and such signing shall be *prima facie* evidence that the said seal was duly affixed and that the same is the lawful seal of the Club.

Mode of execution of documents

7. (1) The Club shall at all times have a fixed address in Trinidad and Tobago for the service of documents on it and that address and any change thereof shall be registered with the Registrar General within twenty-eight days of the date of the incorporation or the change of address as the case may be.

Service of documents

(2) Every document to be served on the Club may be served by leaving the same at, or by sending the same by registered post to the registered address of the Club.

(3) Failure to register the address and any change thereof is a summary offence and renders the Club liable to a fine of one hundred and twenty dollars and to a further fine of ten dollars for each day during which the offence continues after conviction therefor.

8. The Club may from time to time make rules and regulations for the proper conduct of its proceedings and the discharge of its duties, powers and functions with power to vary or revoke such rules and regulations.

Power to make rules

9. Nothing in this Act shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of the State, or of any bodies politic or corporate or of any persons, except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Act and those claiming by, through, from or under them.

Saving of State or other rights
