**AN ACT to provide for the Service of Trinidad and
Tobago for the year ending on the 31st day of
December, 1988.**

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as **Enactment**
follows: —

1. This Act may be cited as the **Appropriation Act, Short title**
1988.

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of seven thousand, six hundred and seventy-five million, six hundred and seventy-six thousand, three hundred and twenty-nine dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1988 under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the Schedule opposite to a Head is hereby appropriated out of the said sum of seven thousand, six hundred and seventy-five million, six hundred and seventy-six thousand, three hundred and twenty-nine dollars for the purposes specified in relation to that Head in the Estimates for the said year.

Commencement

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 1988.
