Act No. 14 of 2007

AN ACT to provide for the Supplementary Appropriation for the Service of Trinidad and Tobago for the Financial Year ending 30th September, 2007 of the sum of the issue which was authorized by the Appropriation Act, 2007.

[Assented to 13th June, 2007]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance Short title (Supplementary Appropriation) Act, 2007.

A further issue from the Consolidated Fund in the sum of three thousand, one hundred and twenty-one million, four hundred and thirteen thousand, eight hundred and twenty-one dollars is authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the financial year ending September 30, 2007 and appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in the Schedule.
