Act No. 49 of 2000

AN ACT to provide for the Service of Trinidad and
Tobago for the financial year ending on the
30th day of September, 2001.

[Assented to 22nd September, 2000]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, Short title
2001.

Issue of
\$15,512,245,876
from Consolidated
Fund authorised

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of fifteen thousand, five hundred and twelve million, two hundred and forty-five thousand, eight hundred and seventy-six dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the financial year ending 30th September, 2001 under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the Schedule opposite to a Head is hereby appropriated out of the said sum of fifteen thousand, five hundred and twelve million, two hundred and forty-five thousand, eight hundred and seventy-six dollars for the purpose specified in relation to that Head in the Estimates for the said year.

Commencement

3. This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 2000.
