AN ORDINANCE for the Incorporation of certain persons as Trustees of the amalgamated bodies known as the Hindu Sanatan Dharma Association of Trinidad and the Sanatan Dharma Board of Control under the name of the Sanatan Dharma Maha-Sabha of Trinidad and Tobago.

WHEREAS there has been established in the Colony an Association known as the Hindu Sanatan Dharma Association of Trinidad (hereinafter called the Association) and the Sanatan Dharma Board of Control (hereinafter called the Board of Control):

And whereas the Association and the Board of Control in pursuance of a joint meeting of the said bodies on the 16th day of April, 1950, resolved to amalgamate the two bodies into one Association to be known as and called the Sanatan Dharma Maha-Sabha of Trinidad and Tobago :

And whereas the Honourable Chankar Maharaj, Ramoutar Sawh, Charles H. Boodoo and Jang Bahadoorsingh have been appointed Trustees of the Sanatan Dharma Maha-Sabha of Trinidad and Tobago :

And whereas it is expedient that the Trustees for the time being of the said amalgamated bodies should be incorporated and should have power to hold lands and other property in trust therefor :

And whereas it is expedient in the premises for the purpose of giving effect to this Ordinance that Ordinance No. 15 of 1932 and Ordinance No. 19 of 1932 should upon the coming into effect of this Ordinance be repealed :

Be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sanatan Dharma Maha-Sabha of Trinidad and Tobago (Incorporation) Ordinance, 1952.

Incorporation of Trustees

2. The said Chankar Maharaj, Ramoutar Sawh, Charles H. Boodoo and Jang Bahadoorsingh and their successors in office as such Trustees as aforesaid shall be, and are hereby created, a body corporate by the name of "The Incorporated Trustees of the Sanatan Dharma Maha-Sabha of Trinidad and Tobago" (hereinafter called the Incorporated Trustees) and by that name shall have perpetual succession and shall and may sue and be sued in all Courts of Justice in the Colony and shall have and use a common seal which may from time to time be changed by the said body.

Trustees may acquire property

3. The Incorporated Trustees shall, subject to the rules, regulations and control of the Sanatan Dharma Maha-Sabha of Trinidad and Tobago, have full power to acquire for the Sanatan Dharma Maha-Sabha of Trinidad and Tobago by purchase, exchange, demise, gift, bequest or otherwise, all lands or other property of what nature or kind soever in perpetuity or for a life or lives or for any term of years, and also any

money, securities for money, goods or chattels whatsoever; and subject to such rules and regulations and control as aforesaid to take, hold and enjoy the same, and subject also to the performance of any trust upon which the said lands or other property, money, securities for money, goods or chattels may have been acquired.

4. It shall be lawful for the Incorporated Trustees, subject to such rules, regulations and control as aforesaid, from time to time by deed under their seal to sell or demise, grant, convey, exchange or otherwise dispose of any lands or other property vested or which may hereafter be vested in them.

5. Nothing in this Ordinance shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of Her Majesty, Her Heirs or Successors or of any bodies politic or corporate or of any other persons except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Ordinance and those claiming by, through, from or under them.

6. Ordinance No. 15 of 1932 and Ordinance No. 19 of 1932 are hereby repealed.
