AN ORDINANCE to amend the Public Health Ordinance,
Ch. 12. No. 4.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Health Short title
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1952, and shall be read as one with
the Public Health Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as the Ch. 12. No. 4
Principal Ordinance.)

2. Subsection (2) of section 36 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the words at the beginning of the said subsection from the word "The" to the word "erected" and substituting therefor the following:—

"The application for the approval of the Local Authority shall be in writing and shall be accompanied by such a number of plans of the buildings to be erected as the Local Authority may require,"

Section 37 of
Principal
Ordinance
amended

3. Section 37 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subsection (4):—

"(4) Every such offence as in the last subsection described shall be deemed to be a continuing offence and punishable on summary conviction by a fine of Five Hundred Dollars and in addition thereto a penalty of Twenty-Five Dollars for every day during which the offence continues."
