AN ORDINANCE to amend the San Fernando Corporation
Ordinance, Ch. 39. No. 7.

[10th June, 1954]

Commencement

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the Enactment
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the San Fernando Short title
Corporation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be read
as one with the San Fernando Corporation Ordinance, in this Ch. 39. No. 7
Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

New section 15A
inserted in
Principal
Ordinance

2. The following new section, to be numbered 15A, is hereby added to the Principal Ordinance, immediately after section 15 :—

"Out-of-pocket
grants to
Councillors

15A. For the purpose of defraying the reasonable out-of-pocket expenses incidental to his office, every member of the Council, other than the Mayor, shall be paid out of the ordinary revenues of the Corporation the sum of thirty dollars per month."

Section 16 of
Principal
Ordinance
amended

3. Section 16 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) by substituting for subsection (2) thereof the following :—

"(2) For the purpose of defraying the reasonable travelling expenses incidental to his office, the Mayor shall be paid out of the ordinary revenues of the Corporation the sum of sixty dollars per month";

(b) by adding immediately after subsection (2) thereof, the following new subsection to be numbered (3) :—

"(3) The Mayor shall receive an honorarium of \$1,800 per annum, payable out of the ordinary revenues of the Corporation by equal monthly instalments at the end of each month."

Passed in Council this twenty-first day of May, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four.
