AN ORDINANCE to amend the Trade Ordinance, 1958, and to re-enact certain regulations and to validate acts done thereunder.

[8th April, 1959.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Trade (Amendment) Ordinance, 1959, and shall be read as one with the Trade Ordinance, 1958, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) by inserting the words and figure “Part I of” immediately before the words “ the Schedule”;
- (b) by renumbering the section as subsection (1) of section 10;
- (c) by inserting the following as subsections (2) and (3) thereof:—

“ (2) The regulations set forth in Part II of the Schedule to this Ordinance as in force on the 24th day of March, 1959 shall, as from the 25th day of March, 1959 be deemed to have continued to have had effect and shall continue to have effect, and any act or thing done or omitted in purported exercise of any of the provisions of the said regulations between the 25th day of March, 1959 and the commencement of the Trade (Amendment) Ordinance, 1959 which would have been validly and properly done or omitted if the said regulations had been in force during the said period shall be deemed to have been validly and properly done or omitted.

(3) The regulations set forth in the Schedule to this Ordinance, and all orders, regulations, licences, permits or other instruments of whatsoever nature made, issued or granted under or by virtue of regulation 42 of the Defence Regulations, 1939 (which expired on the 25th day of March, 1959) or under or by virtue of the provisions of the said regulations set forth in the said Schedule shall be deemed to have been made, issued or granted under and by virtue of the provisions of this Ordinance relating to the making of regulations or orders or the granting of licences, as the case may be, and may accordingly be amended, cancelled or revoked under or by virtue of the said provisions of this Ordinance, but shall continue in force until their expiry, or until they have been revoked or cancelled under or by virtue of the said provisions.”

3. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—
