AN ORDINANCE to make provision for determining the retirement date of Ashton Williams, former Assistant Superintendent of Police in the Trinidad and Tobago Police Force.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Ashton Williams (Date of Retirement) Ordinance, 1960.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the granting of pensions or the determination of the date of retirement from the public service of Trinidad and Tobago, it is hereby declared that, for the purpose of computing the pension and gratuity payable to him, the date of retirement of Ashton Williams, former Assistant Superintendent of Police in the Trinidad and Tobago Police Force, shall be deemed to be the date on which the said Ashton Williams would have retired had he sought and been granted the full extension of leave on the ground of ill-health in accordance with the provisions of regulation 14 of the Leave and Leave Passage Regulations, 1956.

Passed in Council this twenty-ninth day of July, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty.
