AN ORDINANCE to amend the Appropriation Ordinance, 1955.

[1st January, 1956]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Appropriation Ordinance, 1955, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. The First Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended :—

- (a) by substituting for the figures and commas "10,236,850" appearing in respect of the head "35. Education" the figures and commas "10,191,921";
- (b) by substituting for the figures and commas "10,186,850" appearing in respect of the head "41. Health" the figures and commas "10,236,850";
- (c) by substituting for the figures and commas "5,339,632" appearing in respect of the head "50. Works and Hydraulics Extraordinary" the figures and commas "5,524,632";
- (d) by substituting for the figures and commas "5,524,632" appearing in respect of the head "51. Colonial Development and Welfare Schemes" the figures and commas "714,647";.
