AN ORDINANCE to make special provision for the grant of a reduced pension and gratuity to the Reverend Harold Frank Swann, formerly Principal of the Naparima Training College.

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Swann (Gratuity and Reduced Pension) Ordinance, 1956.

Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the grant of pensions, there may be paid from general revenue to the Reverend Harold Frank Swann, formerly Principal of the Naparima Training College, in respect of his service as such Principal, a gratuity of five thousand seven hundred and twenty dollars and a pension, as from the 1st June, 1953, at the rate of one thousand seven hundred and sixteen dollars per annum.

Passed in Council this twenty-third day of March, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.
