AN ORDINANCE to amend further the San Fernando Corporation Ordinance, Ch. 39. No. 7.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

**1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the San Fernando Corporation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be read as one with the San Fernando Corporation Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance, as amended by the San Fernando Corporation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1953, is hereby further amended—

(a) in subsection (2), by substituting the following paragraph for paragraph (c) thereof:—

“(c) is, on the 31st of March, and has been during the whole of the preceding twelve months, resident within the borough.”; and

(b) by repealing subsection (3) thereof.

3. Section 56 of the Principal Ordinance, as enacted by the San Fernando Corporation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1953, is hereby further amended—

(a) in subsection (1), by deleting the words “in respect of qualifying property within the borough”; and

(b) by substituting for subsection (2) thereof the following:—

“(2) The burgess list shall be made out under several heads according to the number of Wards into which the borough is divided. It shall distinguish under each head in separate parts—

(a) the persons entitled to be enrolled as burgesses in respect of qualifying property within the ward; and

(b) the persons entitled to be enrolled as burgesses in respect of residence within the Borough who were resident within the ward on the 31st of March in the year in which the burgess list is made out.”

4. Sections 57 and 58 of the Principal Ordinance, as enacted and amended respectively by the San Fernando Corporation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1953, are hereby repealed.

5. Section 59 of the Principal Ordinance, as amended by the San Fernando Corporation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1953, is hereby further amended—

(a) in subsection (1), by deleting the words and comma “including the list of burgesses qualified in respect of the occupation of lodgings,”; and

(b) by substituting for subsection (2) thereof the following:—

“(2) The burgess list, in respect of each Ward, shall be in the form A in the Fourth Schedule, or in such other form as the Council may from time to time prescribe.”

7. (1) The provisions of this Ordinance shall have effect in relation to the making out of the burgess list and the compilation of the burgess roll in the year 1956 and in succeeding years, and, subject to the provisions of section 13 of the Principal Ordinance, in relation to the election of Councillors at any time after the coming into operation of the said burgess roll in the year 1956 and in succeeding years.

(2) Nothing in this Ordinance shall affect the validity of—

- (a) any burgess roll compiled under the provisions of the Principal Ordinance before the coming into operation of the burgess roll to be compiled in the year 1956, or
- (b) the election of any Councillor elected before the coming into operation of the burgess roll to be compiled in the year 1956.
