AN ORDINANCE to amend the Aid to Pioneer Industries  
Ordinance, Ch. 33. No. 3.

Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Aid to Pioneer  
Industries (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be  
read as one with the Aid to Pioneer Industries Ordinance, Ch. 33. No. 3.  
hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. The following new section, to be numbered 8A, is hereby added to the Principal Ordinance, immediately after section 8 thereof:—

“Power of  
Governor in  
Council to  
extend period  
of relief from  
customs duty  
and of  
income tax  
holiday.

8A. It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council on the application of a pioneer manufacturer to extend to a period not exceeding ten years the period of five years referred to in section 5 and in section 8 respectively, of this Ordinance; and thereupon, for the purposes of each of the said sections, the extended period shall, as regards the pioneer enterprise in respect of which such extension is made, be deemed to be substituted for the said period of five years.”

Passed in Council this eighteenth day of May, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.
