AN ORDINANCE to make special provision for the grant of a gratuity and annual allowance to Leon Fitzroy Ashby, formerly Station Master in the Railway Department.

Enactment.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Ashby (Retiring Allowance) Ordinance, 1956.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the grant of pensions, there may be paid from general revenue to Leon Fitzroy Ashby, formerly employed as a Station Master in the Railway Department, in respect of his services in the said Department, a gratuity of two thousand four hundred and eighty-six dollars and twenty-five cents, and an allowance, as from the 4th May, 1955, at the rate of seven hundred and forty-five dollars and eighty-eight cents per annum.

Authority to pay gratuity of \$2,486.25 and annual allowance of \$745.88 to Leon Fitzroy Ashby.

Passed in Council this 27th day of April in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.
