1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Nurses Registra- Short title.
tion (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be read as one
with the Nurses Registration Ordinance, in this Ordinance

(2) This Ordinance shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by the Governor by proclamation in the *Royal Gazette*.

Section 3 of
the Principal

2. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) by substituting for subsection (2) thereof the following :—

“(2) The register shall consist of the following parts—

- (a) a general part containing the names of all female nurses who satisfy the conditions of admission to that part of the register ;
- (b) a general part containing the names of all male nurses who satisfy the conditions of admission to that part of the register ;
- (c) a supplementary part containing the names of all female and male nurses trained in the nursing and care of persons suffering from mental diseases who satisfy the conditions of admission to that part of the register ;
- (d) a supplementary part containing the names of all female and male nurses trained in the nursing and care of persons suffering from tuberculosis who satisfy the conditions of admission to that part of the register ;
- (e) a supplementary part containing the names of all female nurses trained in the nursing and care of sick children who satisfy the conditions of admission to that part of the register ;
- (f) any other prescribed part.

Where any person satisfies the conditions of admission to any supplementary or prescribed part of the register, his name may be included in that part of the register notwithstanding that it is also included in a general part.” ; and

(b) by adding immediately after subsection (4) thereof the following subsection—

“(5) Any references in sections 8 and 9 of this Ordinance to a female nurse shall be construed as including references to a male nurse.”
