**Act No. 31 of 1966**

AN ACT to authorise the payment of a gratuity and a pension to Alfonse Luces, a former member of the Trinidad and Tobago Police Force.

*[Assented to 13th September, 1966]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, <sup>Enactment</sup> by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Alfonse Luces (Special <sup>Short title</sup> Gratuity and Pension) Act, 1966.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, authority is hereby given for the payment out of the Consolidated Fund to Alfonse Luces, a former member of the Trinidad and Tobago Police Force, of a gratuity in the sum of three thousand four hundred and eighty-four dollars and thirty-seven cents and with effect from the 24th January, 1964, a pension, payable monthly, at the rate of eight hundred and thirty-six dollars and twenty-five cents per annum.
