**Act No. 5 of 1966**

AN ACT to provide for the payment of a special injury allowance to Geoffrey Wilson, a former member of the Special Reserve Police.

*[Assented to 16th June, 1966]*

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Special Injury Allowance Short title (Geoffrey Wilson) Act, 1966.

Special injury  
allowance

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law to the contrary, there shall be paid to Geoffrey Wilson, a former member of the Special Reserve Police, with effect from the 6th day of March, 1961, a monthly allowance in an amount of twelve dollars and fifty cents in respect of an injury received by him on the 27th August, 1944 in the course of the execution of his duty.
