**Act No. 33 of 1965**

[L.S.]

AN ACT to provide for the service of Trinidad and Tobago  
for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1966

[*Assented to 1st January, 1966*]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, <sup>Enactment</sup>  
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and  
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and  
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 1966. <sup>Short title</sup>

Issue of  
\$281,251,174  
from Consolidated  
Fund authorised

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of Two hundred and eighty-one million, two hundred and fifty-one thousand, one hundred and seventy-four dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1966, under the heads of expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the said Schedule opposite to a head is hereby appropriated out of the said sum of Two hundred and eighty-one million, two hundred and fifty-one thousand, one hundred and seventy-four dollars for the purposes specified in relation to that head in the Estimates for the said year.
