AN ORDINANCE to provide that Alroy Nicholls be accepted as a contributor under the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance.

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Alroy Nicholls Pensions Ordinance, 1961.

Short Title.

Interpretation.

**2. In this Ordinance—**

“Committee” means the Public Service Widows and Orphans Pensions Committee established by section 4 of the Widows’ and Orphans’ Pensions Ordinance.

Alroy Nicholls deemed to have been accepted as a contributor under the Widows’ and Orphans’ Pensions Ordinance, Ch. 9. No. 8.

**3. Notwithstanding the Widows’ and Orphans’ Pensions Ordinance, Alroy Nicholls deceased, former Non-Graduate Master of the Government Training College, shall be deemed to have been entitled to the privileges and benefits of a contributor under that Ordinance in respect of the period the 13th day of March, 1958, to the 16th day of September, 1960, as if he had consented to his age being rated up 10 years and had been accepted by the Committee as a contributor on such conditions.**

No refund of contributions to be made.

**4. No refund shall be made of any abatements retained by the Accountant General from the salary of Alroy Nicholls as a contribution under the Widows’ and Orphans’ Pensions Ordinance pending the acceptance of the said Alroy Nicholls by the Committee as a contributor under that Ordinance.**
