AN ORDINANCE to amend the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, Ch. 39. No. 1.

[12th October, 1961]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Port-of-Spain Corporation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1961, and shall be read as one with the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, herein-after referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately before the definition of "Board" the following :

" 'Accountant' means the person for the time being holding the office of Accountant under the Corporation and includes any person acting as Accountant;

'Assistant Accountant' means the person for the time being holding the office of Assistant Accountant under the Corporation and includes any person acting as Assistant Accountant;".

3. The following new section to be numbered 122A is hereby inserted in the Principal Ordinance immediately after section 122 thereof:—

Vouchers  
and  
payments.

"122A. (1) The City Treasurer shall cause vouchers to be made out for all payments out of the funds of the Corporation, save in the case of cash disbursements not exceeding \$24.00; and the City Treasurer is responsible for all vouchers and the correctness thereof.

(2) No payment requiring a voucher may be made unless a voucher therefor has been duly submitted to the Finance Committee.

(3) All vouchers shall be signed by the Chief Officer of the Department to which the payment relates, or, in his absence by his Deputy, if any, and countersigned by the City Treasurer.

(4) All vouchers relating to the City Treasurer's Department shall be signed by the Accountant, or, in his absence the Assistant Accountant, if any, and countersigned by the City Treasurer.

(5) Notwithstanding subsection (2), in cases of urgency money may be paid out on a voucher submitted, signed and countersigned as required by subsection (3) or (4) but the voucher shall be laid before the Finance Committee at their meeting next after the money has been paid."

4. Section 125 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:

Signature  
of cheques.

"125. (1) All cheques issued against any banking account of the Corporation shall be signed by the Accountant or Assistant Accountant, if any, and shall be countersigned by the City Treasurer or the Town Clerk.

(2) The City Treasurer is responsible for the correctness of all cheques referred to in subsection (1).”

5. Subsection (2) of section 122 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed.
