AN ORDINANCE to amend the Weights and Measures Ordinance, Ch. 31. No. 15.

[20th April, 1961.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Weights and Measures (Amendment) Ordinance, 1961, and shall be read as one with

Short title.

Ch. 31. No. 15. the Weights and Measures Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the definition of "Inspector" the following new definition:

" "Minister" means the member of the Cabinet for the time being charged with the administration of the subject of Commerce;".

3. Subsection (1) of section 20 of the Principal Ordinance, as amended by the Weights and Measures (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, is hereby further amended by substituting for the words "The Commissioner of Industry and Commerce" occurring therein the words "The Permanent Secretary to the Minister".
