AN ORDINANCE to make provision for the grant of a gratuity and a pension to Henrietta Morgan, former Public Assistance Officer, Social Assistance Department.

Commencement

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the Enactment. advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Henrietta Morgan Short title. (Special Gratuity and Pension) Ordinance, 1961.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the grant of pensions, there shall be paid from the general revenue of the Territory to Henrietta Morgan, a former Public Assistance Officer, a gratuity of one thousand four hundred and fifty-one dollars and twenty-five cents and a pension with effect from the 23rd day of July, 1956, at a rate of three hundred and forty-eight dollars and thirty cents per annum.

Passed in Council this seventh day of April, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one.
