AN ORDINANCE to provide for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1961.

[29th April, 1961]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with Enactment the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation short title. Ordinance, 1961.

Expenditure of \$213,609,042 authorised.

2. A sum not exceeding two hundred and thirteen million six hundred and nine thousand, and forty-two dollars shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the Consolidated Fund for the service of the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1961.

Purposes for which expenditure authorised.

3. The sum charged by section 2 of this Ordinance is hereby appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule to this Ordinance, and shall be deemed to have been so appropriated from the 1st day of January, 1961.

Sum appropriated in respect of Port Services may be utilised before accounts are closed. (Ordinance No. 20 of 1959).

4. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Exchequer and Audit Ordinance, 1959, any balance of the sum appropriated by this Ordinance in respect of Port Services and unissued at the 31st day of December, 1961 may be utilised before the accounts of the Port Services in respect of the year 1961 are closed for the discharge of any liability incurred during the said year.
