AN ORDINANCE to validate the appointment of Joseph Pounder to act as City Treasurer under the Port-of-Spain Corporation and to validate his acts and omissions in that office and to indemnify him from legal proceedings in respect of such acts or omissions.

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Joseph Pounder Validation of Appointment and Indemnity Ordinance, 1961.

2. (1) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of section 21 of the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, the appointment of Joseph Pounder to act in the office of City Treasurer by the Mayor of the City of Port-of-Spain on the sixteenth day of September, 1956, is not invalid by reason of the fact that the said appointment was not made by the Council of the Port-of-Spain Corporation.

(2) Notwithstanding paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 23 of the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, the appointment of Joseph Pounder to the office of City Treasurer of the Port-of-Spain Corporation with effect from the seventh day of December, 1956, is not invalid by reason of the fact that the appointment was made without the advice of the Local Service Commission of the Port-of-Spain Corporation.

Validation of
acts and
indemnity.

3. Anything done or not done by Joseph Pounder or by any person acting under his direction that would have been validly and properly done or not done if section 2 of this Ordinance had then been law shall be deemed to be and to have been validly and properly done or not done, as the case may be; and Joseph Pounder and every person acting under his direction as aforesaid are hereby freed, acquitted, discharged, and indemnified from all legal proceedings in respect of any such acts or omissions.
