AN ORDINANCE to make provision for the grant of a gratuity and pension to Edna McNee Yuille, former Principal of the School for the Deaf in respect of the entire period of her service as Principal of the School for the Deaf.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Edna McNee Yuille (Special Gratuity and Pension) Ordinance, 1961.

Short title.

Authority to
pay Edna
McNee Yuille
gratuity of

and a pension
of \$513.00
per annum.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the grant of pensions, there shall be paid from the general revenue of the Territory to Edna McNee Yuille, a former Principal of the School for the Deaf, a gratuity of one thousand seven hundred and ten dollars, and a pension with effect from the 1st day of February, 1955, at the rate of five hundred and thirteen dollars per annum.

Passed in Council this second day of June, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one.
