AN ORDINANCE to revise the statutory provisions relating to the remuneration and allowances payable to Mayors, Aldermen and Councillors of Municipal Councils and to Chairmen, Councillors and appointed members of Committees of County Councils.

[1st January, 1959]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof. Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Municipal and County Councils Remuneration and Allowances Ordinance, 1961. Short title.

- (c) Subsection (1) of section 19 is amended by inserting between the words "and any other law;" and the words "and all things done" the following—
 "and in the event of the Deputy Mayor discharging the duties of the Mayor for seven consecutive days or more, he shall, during such period, be entitled in lieu of the Mayor to be paid the reasonable travelling expenses and the honorarium relating to the office of Mayor;"
- The Arima Corporation Ordinance, Ch. 39. No. 11.
- (a) The following new section, to be numbered 15A, is hereby added immediately after section 15 :—
 "Out of pocket grants to Mayor, Aldermen and Councillors." "15A. For the purpose of defraying the reasonable out-of-pocket expenses incidental to his office, the Mayor, each Alderman and each Councillor shall be paid out of the ordinary revenues of the Corporation the sum of seventy-five dollars per month."
- (b) Subsection (2) of section 16 is repealed.
- (c) The following new subsections to be numbered (2) and (3) are hereby added to section 16—
 "Travelling allowance and honorarium of Mayor." "(2) For the purpose of defraying the reasonable travelling expenses incidental to his office, the Mayor shall be paid out of the ordinary revenues of the Corporation the sum of sixty-two dollars and fifty cents per month."
 "(3) The Mayor shall receive an honorarium of \$1,200 per annum, payable out of the ordinary revenues of the Corporation by equal monthly instalments at the end of each month."
- (d) Subsection (1) of section 19 is amended by substituting the words "seven consecutive days or more, he shall, during such period, be entitled in lieu of the Mayor to be paid the reasonable travelling expenses and the honorarium relating to the office of Mayor" for the words "one month or more, he shall, during such period, be entitled in lieu of the Mayor to be paid the reasonable travelling and other expenses incidental to the office of Mayor".
- The County Councils Ordinance, Ch. 39. No. 15.
- (a) Section 82 is amended by adding immediately after subsection (4) thereof, the following new subsection to be numbered (4A)—
 "(4A) In the absence or illness of the Chairman of a County Council, the Vice-Chairman of that County Council shall be deemed to have authority to exercise all the powers and discharge all the duties vested in and imposed upon the Chairman of that County Council under this Ordinance; and in the event of

the Vice-Chairman of such County Council discharging the duties of the Chairman thereof for seven consecutive days or more, he shall, during such period, be entitled in lieu of the Chairman to be paid the reasonable travelling expenses and the honorarium relating to the office of Chairman of the County Council; and all things done, exercised, or suffered by a Vice-Chairman of a County Council under this section shall be as valid and effectual in all respects as if they had been done, exercised, or suffered by the Chairman of the County Council."

(b) Section 115 is repealed and replaced by the following—

"Out of pocket grants to councillors and appointed members." "115. (1) For the purpose of defraying the reasonable out-of-pocket expenses incidental to his office, every councillor, other than a councillor of the County Council for Tobago, shall be paid—

- (a) the sum of ninety-three dollars and seventy-five cents per month if he is living within a radius of twenty miles of the office of the County Council, or
- (b) the sum of one hundred dollars per month if he is living outside a radius of twenty miles of the office of the County Council.

(2) For the purpose of defraying the reasonable out-of-pocket expenses incidental to his office, every councillor of the County Council for Tobago shall be paid—

- (a) the sum of one hundred and seven dollars and eighty-one cents per month if he is living within a radius of twenty miles of the office of the County Council, or
- (b) the sum of one hundred and fifteen dollars per month if he is living outside a radius of twenty miles of the office of the County Council.

(3) The chairman of every committee of a County Council, other than the County Council for Tobago, shall, in addition to any sum payable to him under subsection (1) of this section, be paid the sum of twenty dollars and eighty-three cents per month for the purpose of defraying the reasonable out-of-pocket expenses incidental to his office.

(4) The chairman of every committee of the County Council for Tobago shall, in addition to any sum payable to him under subsection (2) of this section, be paid the sum of twenty-three dollars and ninety-six cents per month for the purpose of defraying the reasonable out-of-pocket expenses incidental to his office.

(5) Every appointed member of a committee of a County Council, other than the County Council for Tobago, shall be paid the sum of twenty-five dollars per month for the purpose of defraying the reasonable out-of-pocket expenses incidental to his office.

(6) Every appointed member of a committee of the County Council for Tobago shall be paid the sum of twenty-eight dollars and seventy-five cents per month for the purpose of defraying the reasonable out-of-pocket expenses incidental to his office."

(c) The following sections are hereby inserted as sections 116 and 117—

"Travelling expenses and honorarium of Chairman of a County Council."

"116 (1) For the purpose of defraying the reasonable travelling expenses incidental to his office, the Chairman of a County Council, other than the County Council for Tobago, shall be paid the sum of eighty-three dollars and thirty-three cents per month.

(2) For the purpose of defraying the reasonable travelling expenses incidental to his office, the Chairman of the County Council for Tobago shall be paid the sum of ninety-six dollars per month.

(3) The Chairman of a County Council, other than the County Council for Tobago, shall receive an honorarium of one thousand dollars per annum, payable by equal monthly instalments at the end of each month.

(4) The Chairman of the County Council for Tobago shall receive an honorarium of one thousand one hundred and fifty dollars per annum, payable by equal monthly instalments at the end of each month."

(5) The offices of Chairman and Acting Chairman of a County Council shall not be offices of emolument under the Crown for any of the purposes of the Trinidad and Tobago (Constitution) Orders in Council, 1950 to 1959".
