AN ACT to amend the Roman Catholic Archbishop
Incorporation Ordinance, No. 41 of 1960.

[Assented to 18th July, 1963.]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by ^{Enactment} and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Roman Catholic ^{Short title} Archbishop Incorporation (Amendment) Act, 1963.

2. The Roman Catholic Archbishop Incorporation Ordinance, 1960 is hereby amended by inserting immediately after section 4 thereof the following:

'Rights etc.,
transferred
to the
Corporation

4A. (1) The Corporation has all the rights, privileges, obligations and liabilities and all real and personal property, including things in action, conferred or imposed on or vested in the former Corporation immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance.

(2) In this section, "the former Corporation" means the body corporate established by the Roman Catholic Archbishop Incorporation Ordinance."

Commencement

3. This Act has effect from the 31st day of December, 1960.
