AN ACT to provide that Daniel Augustine Campbell be deemed to have been accepted as a contributor under the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance.

[Assented to 18th July, 1963.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by ^{Enactment} and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Widows' and Orphans' ^{Short title} Pensions (Daniel Augustine Campbell) Act, 1963.

Interpretation**2. In this Act,**

“the Committee” means the Public Service Widows’ and Orphans’ Pensions Committee established by section 4 of the Ordinance;

“the Ordinance” means the Widows’ and Orphans’ Pensions Ordinance.

Daniel Augustine Campbell deemed to have been accepted as a contributor under the Widows’ and Orphans’ Pensions Ordinance

3. Notwithstanding any provision contained in the Ordinance or any Act amending the same, Daniel Augustine Campbell, deceased, former Physicist in the Ministry of Health and Housing of Trinidad and Tobago, shall be deemed to have been entitled to the privileges and benefits of a contributor under the Ordinance with effect from the 6th day of February, 1956, as if he had undergone a medical examination to the satisfaction of the Committee and had been accepted by the Committee as a contributor.

No refund of contribution to be made

4. No refund shall be made of any abatement from the salary of the said Daniel Augustine Campbell retained by the Accountant General as a contribution under the Ordinance pending his acceptance by the Committee as a contributor.
