**Act No. 10 of 1963**

AN ACT to amend the Church of England Incorporation  
Ordinance, No. 14 of 1930

[Assented to 2nd May, 1963]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment  
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and  
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and  
by the authority of the same as follows :

1. This Act may be cited as the Church of England Short Title  
Incorporation (Amendment) Act, 1963, and shall be read  
as one with the Church of England Incorporation Ordinance  
hereinafter referred to as the Ordinance. No. 14 of 1930

2. The following section is hereby inserted in the Ordinance immediately after section 6 thereof :

Power of Trustees to borrow, &c. "6A. The Trustees may also, subject to the said rules, regulations and control aforesaid, from time to time borrow money and may, for the repayment of the same, by deed under their seal give and execute mortgages, charges, hypothecations, pledges or other securities of their real or personal property or make any such arrangements as they may consider expedient, with such covenants, powers and provisions as they may think proper : Provided that any such dealing in any such property shall be subject also to any restraint, reservation or condition contained in the document under which they shall have acquired title thereto."
