AN ACT to enable Pedro Berment a former member of the Trinidad and Tobago Fire Service to qualify for retirement benefits.

[Assented to 5th December, 1970]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Pedro Berment (Qualifi- Short title
cation for Retirement Benefits) Act, 1970.

2. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, authority is hereby given for the periods during which Pedro Berment was a member of the Trinidad and Tobago Fire Service, that is to say from 2nd July, 1951 to 23rd August, 1962 and from 1st April, 1967 to 15th August, 1969, to be treated as one continuous period of service, in order that the said Pedro Berment may qualify for retirement benefits under the Fire Service Act, 1965.
