TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO
Act No. 43 of 1970

[L.S.]

AN ACT to provide for the Incorporation of a body to be known as the Stri Sevak Sabha (Women's Service League) of Trinidad and Tobago.

[Assented to 4th November, 1970]

WHEREAS there has been established in Trinidad and Tobago a religious, social and cultural body known as the Stri Sevak Sabha (Women's Service League) since 1953.

And whereas it is felt necessary to incorporate an organization of the Hindu women in this community.

And whereas Trustees have been elected and have agreed to accept such office in Trinidad and Tobago and to hold property for any of the uses or purposes of the said Stri Sevak Sabha in Trinidad and Tobago.

And whereas it is expedient that the Trustees for the time being of the Stri Sevak Sabha should be incorporated and should have powers to hold land and other property in trust for the Sabha.

- Enactment BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago and by the authority of the same as follows :—
- Short title **1.** This Act may be cited as the Stri Sevak Sabha Incorporation Act, 1970.
- Incorporation of Trustees **2.** The Trustees for the time being and their successors in office as Trustees of the Stri Sevak Sabha shall be and are hereby created a body corporate by the name of the Stri Sevak Sabha Incorporated (hereinafter called "the Trustees") and by that name shall have perpetual succession and also by that name may sue and be sued and shall have a Common Seal with power to change such seal.
- Power to acquire real and personal property **3.** Subject to the rules regulations and control of the governing body the Trustees shall have full power to acquire for the Stri Sevak Sabha by gift, grant, purchase, demise, exchange or otherwise any lands, buildings, messuages and hereditaments of what nature or kind soever in perpetuity or for life or for lives and for a term of years and also any moneys, goods and chattels and subject to such rules, regulations and control aforesaid and to the performance of any trust upon which the said lands, buildings, messuages, hereditaments, moneys, goods and chattels may have been acquired to take hold and enjoy the same.
- Power to dispose of real and personal property **4.** Subject to the rules regulations and control aforesaid and to the performance of any trust as aforesaid the Trustees may sell, demise, grant, convey, transfer, surrender, alienate or otherwise dispose of any property by this Act vested in them or which may hereafter be acquired by or become vested in them.

5. The aims and objects of the Stri Sevak Sabha are as follows:—

Objects and
functions

- (a) To carry on Hindu religious activities.
- (b) To do social work, irrespective of race, creed, &c.
- (c) To encourage educational activities.
- (d) To publish literature and to give lectures.
- (e) To hold property which belongs to the Stri Sevak Sabha.
- (f) To encourage Inter-Faiths and Inter-Racial activities.
- (g) To establish branches of this body.
- (h) To do all such acts and things as are necessary or proper for the furtherance of the religious social and cultural advancement of Hindu women.

6. (a) The Stri Sevak Sabha shall at all times have a fixed address in Trinidad and Tobago for the service of documents on the Sabha and such address or any change thereof shall be registered with the Registrar General.

(b) Any document may be served on the Sabha by leaving the same at or by sending the same by registered post to the address as registered under sub-section (1) of this section.

7. All deeds, documents and other instruments requiring the Seal of the Stri Sevak Sabha shall be sealed with Common Seal in the presence of any four members of the Executive Body of the Stri Sevak Sabha who shall sign every such deed, document, or other instrument to which the Common Seal is affixed, and such signing shall be prima facie evidence that the seal was duly affixed and that the same is the lawful Seal of this Body.

8. Nothing in this Act shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of Her Majesty Her Heirs successors or of any bodies politic or corporate or any persons except such as are mentioned in this Act and those claiming by through from or under them.
