TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 30 of 1970

[L.S.]

AN ACT to provide that Deonarine Lutchmansingh deceased, former Teacher II attached to Queen's Royal College and Albert Norville deceased, former cleaner attached to the John S. Donaldson Technical Institute under the Ministry of Education and Culture, be deemed to have been accepted as contributors under the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance, Ch. 9. No. 8.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment} by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Widows' and Orphans' ^{Short title} Pensions (Lutchmansingh and Norville) Act, 1970.

Interpretation

2. In this Act—

“Committee” means the Public Service Widows’ and Orphans’ Pensions Committee established by section 4 of the Ordinance;

“the Ordinance” means the Widows’ and Orphans’ Pensions Ordinance.

Deonarine Lutchmansingh and Albert Norville deemed to have been accepted as contributors under the Widows’ and Orphans’ Pensions Ordinance

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Ordinance, Deonarine Lutchmansingh deceased, a former Teacher II attached to Queen’s Royal College and Albert Norville, deceased a former cleaner attached to the John S. Donaldson Technical Institute, under the Ministry of Education and Culture shall be deemed to have been public officers, and entitled to the privileges and benefits as contributors under the Ordinance, with effect from the 5th day of April, 1967, and the 29th day of September, 1966 respectively, as if they had been accepted by the Committee as contributors.

Widows’ pension

4. The widows of the late Deonarine Lutchmansingh and of the late Albert Norville shall each be awarded a widow’s pension to be calculated in accordance with the provisions of the Ordinance.

No refund of contributions to be made

5. No refund shall be made of any abatement from the salary of the said Deonarine Lutchmansingh or of the said Albert Norville retained by the Accountant General as their respective contributions under the Ordinance pending their acceptance by the Committee as contributors.
