

TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 15 of 1970

[L.S.]

An Act to amend the Constitution of Trinidad and Tobago.

[Assented to 22nd May, 1970]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Trinidad and Tobago short title Constitution (Amendment) Act, 1970.

Constitution amended.

2. Subsection (3) of section 58 of the Constitution set out in the Second Schedule to the Trinidad and Tobago Constitution Order-in-Council, 1962, is amended by the substitution of the words "not more than three Ministers" for the words "not more than two Ministers" occurring in lines 2 and 3 thereof; and by the substitution of the words "not more than three other Ministers" for the words "not more than two other Ministers" occurring in lines 4 and 5 thereof.
