TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 7 of 1970

[L.S]

AN ACT to provide for the payment of a gratuity and a reduced pension to Miss Matilda Simmons former Matron of the School for the Deaf.

[Assented to 20th March, 1970]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment} by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Matilda Simmons ^{Short title} (Special Gratuity and Pension) Act, 1970.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, authority is hereby given for the payment out of the Consolidated Fund to Matilda Simmons, former matron of the School for the Deaf of an ex-gratia gratuity in the sum of one thousand and seventy dollars, and, with effect from 13th October, 1961, a pension payable monthly at the rate of two hundred and fifty-six dollars and eighty cents per annum.
