TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

**Act No. 44 of 1969**

AN ACT to provide for the payment of superannuation benefits to Grace Georges formerly Principal Officer in the Ministry of Finance and Lydia Agatha Harper formerly Principal of the School for the Deaf.

*[Assented to 30th December, 1969]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, <sup>Enactment</sup> by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Georges and Harper <sup>Short title</sup> (Gratuity and Pensions) Act, 1969.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the grant of pensions there shall be paid from the Consolidated Fund—

- (a) to Grace Georges a former Principal Officer in the Ministry of Finance, a gratuity of seven thousand and seventy-two dollars and sixty-three cents and a pension with effect from the 5th day of January, 1966, at the rate of one thousand, six hundred and ninety-seven dollars and forty-three cents per annum;
- (b) to Lydia Agatha Harper, a former Principal of the School for the Deaf, a gratuity of four thousand, six hundred dollars and a pension with effect from the 12th day of September, 1965, at the rate of one thousand, one hundred and four dollars per annum.
