Act No. 13 of 1971

An Act to authorise the payment of a gratuity to the legal personal representative of the late Alexander Lashley, a former Temporary Attendant, Ministry of Health.

[Assented to 26th April, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Alexander Lashley, Short title Deceased (Gratuity) Act, 1971.

Authority to pay gratuity

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, there shall be paid out of the Consolidated Fund, a gratuity in the sum of two thousand and sixty-four dollars to the legal personal representative of Alexander Lashley, deceased, a former Temporary Attendant in the Ministry of Health.
