**Act No. 12 of 1971**

AN ACT to vary the sums appropriated to Heads of Expenditure set out in the Appropriation Act, 1970.

*[Assented to 8th April, 1971]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by <sup>Enactment</sup> and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance (Variation of <sup>Short title</sup> Appropriation) Act, 1971.
