Act No. 9 of 1971

AN ACT to provide for the payment of a pension and gratuity to Alphonso Toppin a former Pump Attendant, Water and Sewerage Authority.

[Assented to 15th April, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment} by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Alphonso Toppin ^{Short title} (Pension and Gratuity) Act, 1971.

2. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any other law relating to the grant of pensions there shall be paid to Alphonso Toppin in respect of his service during the period 17th May, 1955 to 18th November, 1966, in the Water Division, Ministry of Works and thereafter in the Water and Sewerage Authority, a pension at the rate of three hundred and fourteen dollars and thirty-four cents per annum and a gratuity of one thousand three hundred and nine dollars and seventy-five cents.

(2) Any sums paid before the commencement of this Act to the said Alphonso Toppin by way of gratuity under the Provident Fund Ordinance (exclusive of the compulsory deposits made by the said Alphonso Toppin to the Provident Fund and the interest thereon) shall be set off against any sums to which he shall become entitled under subsection (1).
