Act No. 8 of 1968

AN ACT to confer pension benefits under the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance, Ch. 9. No. 8, on the dependants of the late Boysie Barkarr.

[Assented to 9th April, 1968]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by ^{Enactment} and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Barkarr (Widows' and ^{Citation} Orphans' Benefits) Act, 1968.

2. In this Act "former Ordinance" means the Muslim Marriage and Divorce Registration Ordinance, which was repealed and replaced by the Muslim Marriage and Divorce Ordinance, 1961.

3. Notwithstanding that the person who purported to effect a Muslim marriage between Boysie Barkarr and Vera Singh on the 29th day of May, 1949, was not on such date a marriage officer appointed under the former Ordinance, it is hereby declared that the said Vera Singh now known as Vera Barkarr and the children of her union with the said Boysie Barkarr are eligible to receive the pensions payable to widows and children under and in accordance with the provision of section 5 of the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance.
