TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 24 of 1967

AN ACT to provide for the Incorporation of a Body to be known as the Incorporated Trustees of the Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ of the Apostolic Faith of Trinidad and Tobago

[Assented to 8th September, 1967]

WHEREAS there has been established in Trinidad and Tobago the Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ of the Apostolic Faith of Trinidad and Tobago a branch of the Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ of the Apostolic Faith Incorporated duly registered in Trinidad and Tobago, Preamble

And whereas Edwin Branstone Johnson, Sobassia Jaggernauth, Iona J. Johnson, Ina Phillips and Jagassah Jaggernauth of Trinidad and Tobago have been appointed Trustees of the said Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ of the Apostolic Faith of Trinidad and Tobago by the Church Council thereof.

And whereas the said Trustees so appointed have been requested and have agreed to accept office as such Trustees to represent the said Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ of the Apostolic Faith in this country and to hold property for any of the uses or purposes of the Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ of the Apostolic Faith of Trinidad and Tobago in the said country.

And whereas it is expedient that the Trustees for the time being of the Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ of the Apostolic Faith of Trinidad and Tobago should be incorporated and should have powers to hold lands and other property in trust for the said Church.

Enactment

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ of the Apostolic Faith of Trinidad and Tobago Incorporation Act, 1967.

2. Edwin Branstone Johnson, Sobassia Jaggernauth, Iona J. Johnson, Ina Phillips and Jagassah Jaggernauth and their Successors in Office as Trustees of the Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ of the Apostolic Faith in Trinidad and Tobago shall be and are hereby created a body corporate by the name of "The Incorporated Trustees of the Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ of the Apostolic Faith of Trinidad and Tobago (hereinafter called "the Trustees") and by that name shall have perpetual succession and shall

and may sue and be sued and shall have and use a Common Seal which seal shall be used only in the presence of at least two members.

3. All property real and personal of what nature soever in Trinidad and Tobago, now vested in the Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ of the Apostolic Faith Incorporated shall be and the same is hereby vested in the Trustees. ^{Vesting Property}

4. The Trustees shall, subject to the rules, regulations and control of the Church Council, have full power from time to time:— ^{Powers of Corporation}

- (a) to acquire by purchase, exchange, demise, gift, bequest or otherwise real and personal property or any estate or interest therein and also any money, securities for money, goods or chattels whatsoever;
- (b) by deed under their seal to sell, demise, grant, convey, exchange, surrender or otherwise dispose of any property vested or which may hereafter be vested in them;
- (c) to borrow money and for the repayment of the same by deed under their seal to give and execute mortgages, charges, pledges or other securities or assurances of their real and personal property or to make such arrangements as they may consider expedient with such covenants, powers and provisions as they may think proper.

5. (a) The Trustees shall at all times have a fixed address in Trinidad and Tobago for the service of documents on the Trustees and such address and any change thereof shall be registered with the Registrar General.

(b) Any document may be served on the Trustees by leaving the same at or by sending the same by registered post to the address as registered under subsection (a) of this section.

6. Nothing in this Act shall affect the rights of Her Majesty, her heirs and successors or of any bodies politic or corporate or of any other persons except such as are mentioned in this Act and those claiming by, from or under them.
