**Act No. 23 of 1967**

[L.S.]

AN ACT to provide for the Incorporation of the Trustees of  
a body to be known as the "Incorporated International  
Pentecostal Assembly" of Trinidad and Tobago.

*[Assented to 8th September, 1967]*

WHEREAS there has been established in the Territory of <sup>Preamble</sup>  
Trinidad and Tobago a church known as the "International  
Pentecostal Assembly".

And whereas a representative body of the members of the Churches of the International Pentecostal Assembly in Trinidad and Tobago, hereinafter called "the Church Council" has been constituted comprising of a Chairman, being for the time the Superintendent of the Assembly in the Caribbean or in his absence, his nominee, and representatives of the various Churches of the International Pentecostal Assembly in the area.

And whereas the Reverend Peter Hakim Hosein, of Indian Walk, Princes Town, by virtue of his office of Superintendent in Trinidad and Tobago, and Kelvin Hosein of King Street, Princes Town, and Deonarine Ragbir of Oropouche River Road, Barrackpore, and Razack Khan of Bonne Aventure Road, Gasparillo and Ramroop Jagger-nauth of Kanhai Road, Barrackpore, have been appointed as Trustees of the International Pentecostal Assembly in Trinidad and Tobago by the said Churches Council.

And whereas the said Trustees so appointed have been requested and they have agreed to accept the office as such in Trinidad and Tobago, and to hold property for any of the uses or purposes of the said churches in Trinidad and Tobago.

And whereas it is expedient that the trustees for the time being of the said International Pentecostal Assembly should be incorporated and should have powers to hold lands, and other property in trust for the said church.

**Enactment**

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Trustees of the International Pentecostal Assembly Churches Incorporation Act, 1967.

**Incorporation  
of Trustees**

2. The Reverend Peter Hakim Hosein and his successors in office as Superintendent of the International Pentecostal Assembly Churches in Trinidad and Tobago and Kelvin

Hosein, Deonarine Ragbir, Razack Khan, Ramroop Jaggernauth and their successors in office as Trustees of the International Pentecostal Assembly Churches in Trinidad and Tobago shall be, and are hereby created a body corporate by the name of the Incorporated Trustees of the International Pentecostal Assembly of Trinidad and Tobago (hereinafter called "the Trustees"), and by that name shall have perpetual succession and also by that name may sue and be sued, and shall have a common seal with power to change such seal.

3. All churches, chapels, mission houses, vicarages, lands and buildings formerly belonging to the International Pentecostal Assembly of Trinidad and Tobago be vested in the Trustees of the said International Pentecostal Assembly of Trinidad and Tobago, and appropriated to the uses of the International Pentecostal Assembly of Trinidad and Tobago are hereby transferred to and vested in the Trustees of the International Pentecostal Assembly of Trinidad and Tobago.

4. Subject to the rules and regulations and control of the Church Council in Trinidad and Tobago, the Trustees shall have full power to acquire for the International Pentecostal Assembly in Trinidad and Tobago, by gift, grant, purchase, demise, or otherwise any lands, buildings, messuages, and hereditaments, of what nature or kind so ever in perpetuity or for life or lives or for a term of years, and also any moneys, goods and chattels and subject to such rules, regulations and control aforesaid and to the performance of any trusts upon which the said lands, buildings, messuages, hereditaments, moneys, goods and chattels may have been acquired to take, hold and enjoy the same.

5. Subject to the rules, regulations and control aforesaid and to the performance of such trusts as aforesaid, and except as hereinafter provided the trustees may sell,

demise, grant, convey, transfer, alienate or otherwise dispose of any property by this Act vested in them or which may be hereafter acquired by or becomes vested in them.

6. Nothing in this Act shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of Her Majesty, Her Heirs or successors or of any bodies politic, or corporate, or of any other persons except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Act and those claiming by, through, from or under them.

#### SCHEDULE

##### PART I

All and Singular that certain piece or parcel of land situate at Cumuto in the Ward of Savana Grande in the County of Victoria in the Territory of Trinidad comprising One Lot be the same more or less and bounded on the North by lands of Tazmool Hosein, on the South by portion of lands of the said Tazmool Hosein, on the East by portion of the said lands of the said Tazmool Hosein and on the West by the public road known as the Cumuto Road or howsoever otherwise the same may be known abutted, bounded or described together with the building situate and standing thereon, and appurtenances thereto belonging.

##### PART II

All and Singular that certain piece or parcel of land situate at Basse Terre, Moruga in the Ward of Moruga in the County of Victoria in the said Territory of Trinidad, comprising One and a Half Lots be the same more or less and bounded on the North by lands now or lately of Betsy Loomy, South by Cha Cha Trace, on the East by lands now or lately of Betsy Loomy and on the West by lands now or lately of the said Betsy Loomy or howsoever otherwise the same may be known abutted, bounded or described together with the building situate and standing thereon and out offices and appurtenances thereto belonging.

##### PART III

All and Singular that certain wooden and concrete building measuring 20 feet by 50 feet and covered with galvanized iron sheets and situate at Gasparillo Village in the Ward of Pointe-a-Pierre in the County of Victoria in the said Territory of Trinidad on lands rented from Mr. Stewart.

##### PART IV

All and Singular that certain concrete building measuring 20 feet by 30 feet and covered with galvanized iron sheets and situate at Jeffers Halt, Tabaquite-Rio Claro Road in the Ward of Charuma in the County of Nariva-Mayaro, in the said Territory of Trinidad on rented lands of David Baboolal.

PART V

All and Singular that certain concrete and wooden structure measuring 20 feet by 30 feet and covered with galvanized iron sheets and situate at Clarke Road, in the Ward of Siparia in the County of St. Patrick in the Territory of Trinidad, and standing on rented lands of Ramharack.

PART VI

All and Singular that certain concrete and wooden structure measuring 22 feet by 40 feet and covered with galvanized iron sheets and situate at Siparia, in the Ward of Siparia in the County of St. Patrick in the Territory of Trinidad and standing on rented lands of Mary Bastein.

PART VII

All and Singular that certain wooden structure measuring 18 feet by 30 feet and covered with galvanized iron sheets and situate at Rock Road, Penal, in the Ward of Siparia in the County of St. Patrick in the Territory of Trinidad on rented lands of Robert Sooknanan.
