TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO
Act No. 31 of 1969

AN ACT to amend the Factories Ordinance, Ch. 30. No. 2.

[Assented to 25th September, 1969]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by ^{Enactment} and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Factories (Amendment) ^{Short title} Act, 1969.

2. The Factories Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) in section 3 thereof, by inserting in its appropriate alphabetical order the following definition—

“ “Minister” means the Minister of Labour”;

(b) in section 22 thereof by substituting for subsection (13) the following:—

“(13) For the purposes of this section and of any regulations or orders made in pursuance thereof the expression “competent person” means a person appointed by the Minister and who is a qualified engineer with experience in the construction, maintenance or repair of electrically or mechanically driven hoists and lifts.”;

(c) by substituting a reference to the Minister for any reference to the Governor-General wherever such a reference occurs therein other than in section 33, 40, 61, 68 and 72, in line four of section 25, in line three of section 42 and in the Schedule.

3. A reference in the Boilers Regulations to the Governor-General shall be read as a reference to the Minister, wherever such a reference occurs.
