Act No. 40 of 1969

AN ACT to provide for the Service of Trinidad and Tobago
for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1970.

[Assented to 18th December, 1969]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by ^{Enactment}
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the
authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 1970. Short title.

Issue of
\$362,285,622
from Consolidated
Fund authorised.

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of Three hundred and sixty-two million, two hundred and eighty-five thousand, six hundred and twenty-two dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1970, under the heads of expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the Schedule opposite to a head is hereby appropriated out of the said sum of Three hundred and sixty-two million, two hundred and eighty-five thousand, six hundred and twenty-two dollars for the purposes specified in relation to that head in the Estimates for the said year
