**Act No. 22 of 1969**

AN ACT to make provision for determining the basis on which a gratuity and pension should be computed in respect of Sylvester Placide Barnes, a former Assistant Secretary, Ministry of Finance.

*[Assented to 21st July, 1969]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, **Enactment** by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago and by the authority of the same, as follows: —

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Sylvester Placide Barnes (Pension and Gratuity) Act, 1969.

Basis of computation of pension and gratuity

2. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of any law relating to the basis to be taken for the purpose of computing the amount of a public officer's pension, gratuity or allowance, it is hereby declared that the pension and gratuity payable to Sylvester Placide Barnes, a former Assistant Secretary, Ministry of Finance, shall be computed on the basis of the salary of the said Sylvester Placide Barnes at the date of his retirement.

(2) Any sums paid before the commencement of this Act to the said Sylvester Placide Barnes by way of pension and gratuity shall be set off against any sums to which he shall become entitled to be paid under subsection (1).
