AN ACT to amend the Insurance Act, 1966.

[Assented to 27th May, 1969]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Insurance (Amendment) ^{Short title}
Act, 1969.

Interpretation

2. In this Act, a reference to the Act is a reference to the Insurance Act, 1966.

Section 168
of Act amended

3. Subsection (2) of section 168 of the Act is amended by substituting the words, "except that where, in any case other than that of an appeal under section 35, a person" for the words "unless that person" occurring in line five therein.

New section 170A
added

4. The Act is amended by inserting immediately after section 170 the following new section:—

"Conse-
quence of
non-com-
pliance with
section 33

170A. A company who fails to comply with any direction of the Supervisor acting under section 33 within the time limited thereby may be ordered by the Supervisor to cease the issue of new policies; and where a company contravenes an order made under this section, it is guilty of an offence."

Commencement

5. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation at the commencement of the Act.
