AN ORDINANCE to repeal the Ordinance No 4. of 1869, entitled "An Ordinance for the appointment of a Surgeon General, and to make other provision in lieu thereof."

WHEREAS on the twenty-third day of February, in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, an Ordinance was passed in Council, entitled "An Ordinance for the appointment of a Surgeon General;" And whereas it is expedient to repeal the said Ordinance: Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council, as follows:—

1. The said Ordinance of the twenty-third day of February, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, shall be and the same is hereby repealed.

2. It shall be lawful for Her Majesty the Queen, her heirs and successors from time to time to appoint such person as she or they may see fit, being a duly qualified medical practitioner, to be Surgeon General for the Island of Trinidad, and every such person so appointed shall hold office during the pleasure of Her Majesty the Queen, her heirs and successors.

3. The Surgeon General shall ex-officio be a member of the Medical Board, and shall have the general superintendence of the several hospitals and medical establishments supported by the Government, and shall, once in every year, make a report in writing to the Governor as to the state and condition of such establishments; and all requisitions for medicines and surgical instruments required for the use of any such hospital or medical establishment shall be submitted to, and approved by, such Surgeon General.

4. The Surgeon General shall be the consulting surgeon of the colonial hospital and the medical attendant of the police force, in the town of Port of Spain.

5. There shall be paid to the Surgeon-General from the Colonial Treasury, a salary at the rate of five hundred pounds per annum.
