AN ORDINANCE to amend the Law as to the Administration of Justice by Stipendiary Justices of the Peace.

(L. S.) HENRY T. IRVING.

11th May, 1880.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council as follows:—

Notwithstanding anything in any Ordinance, a Stipendiary Justice of the Peace to whom a district is assigned under Section 3 of the Ordinance No. 5, of 1868, intitled "An Ordinance respecting the Summary Administration of Justice," may in any place within such district, and moreover if such district immediately adjoins any part of the borough of Port of Spain may in any place within the said borough, hear and determine any action, suit or other matter which as Stipendiary Justice of such district he is competent to hear and determine.
