AN ORDINANCE to authorise the Governor to alter the fees to be taken in respect of certain proceedings before Justices of the Peace.

WHEREAS by the Ordinance No. 5 of 1868, intituled "An Ordinance respecting the Summary Administration of Justice," it is provided that, except in certain cases, the fees specified in the table of fees contained in Schedule A to the said Ordinance shall be allowed and taken in every proceeding had before any Justice of the Peace, and it is expedient that the Governor should have power to alter the fees appointed as aforesaid:

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council, as follows:—

Commence-

1. This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as "The Summary Jurisdiction (Fees) Ordinance, 1879."

Power to

2. The Governor may from time to time by proclamation make, alter, and revoke a table of fees to be allowed and taken in all proceedings before any Stipendiary or other Justice of the Peace to which the said table of fees contained in the said Schedule A applies. Every table of fees contained in any such proclamation shall be deemed to be substituted for and shall have the same effect as the table of fees contained in the said Schedule A, and wherever in the said Ordinance or in

any other Ordinance reference is made to the said table of fees in the said Schedule A, such reference shall be deemed to apply to the table of fees for the time being in force by virtue of a proclamation under this Ordinance.

3. Every proclamation under this Ordinance shall be published in the *Royal Gazette*, and shall come into operation on the day specified in that behalf in such proclamation, or if no such day is specified, upon the day on which the proclamation is first published in the *Royal Gazette*. Publication of
