AN ORDINANCE for altering the time at which "The Real Property Ordinance, 1870," shall come into operation.

**W**HEREAS by "The Real Property Ordinance, 1870," Section 135, it is enacted that the said Ordinance shall commence and take effect from and after the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one :

And whereas it is expedient that the time at which the said recited Ordinance shall come into operation shall be deferred. Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council, as follows :

1. Section 135 of "The Real Property Ordinance, 1870," is hereby repealed.

2. The said "Real Property Ordinance, 1870," shall commence and take effect upon and from such day as the Governor may, by proclamation under his hand and seal, appoint.

Passed in Council this tenth day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy.
